SUMMONING GRAND JURIES

ORDER FOR IMPANELMENT

Section XIV of the <u>Amended Plan for the Random Selection of Grand and Petit Jurors</u>, for the United States District Court, Eastern District of Washington, provides for impaneling jurors.

This Court finds that the public interest so requires that grand jury panels be summoned at regular intervals. Pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. P. 6(a)(1), this Court orders that grand jurors be summoned every eighteen months, as follows:

Two grand jury panels shall be summoned from the Qualified Jury Wheel for Division A every eighteen months;

One grand jury panel shall be summoned from the Qualified Jury Wheel for Division B every eighteen months; and

Grand jurors from all three panels shall serve for a term not in excess of eighteen months unless extended by the Court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
